## TOWN BOARD MEETING MINUTES

## March 6, 2023

**Call to Order Town Board Meeting**: Chairperson Tom Winker called the Town Board Meeting to order at 6:00p.m. Quorum established. Pledge of Allegiance recited. Verification of compliance with WI Open Meetings Law.

**Minutes**: Tom Winker to approve the minutes of the February Town Board meeting: Tom Bichler motioned to approve the minutes, Bill Janeshek seconded. Motion unanimously carried.

Zoning Permits: Charlie Parks reported zoning permits issued in February: no permits issued.

**Roads**: Silver Beach Project: advertisement currently running in press for 2 weeks for notification of bids. March 20th there will be a pre-bid meeting to take place at 10:00 at the site. Special town board meeting will have to be scheduled on April 10th at 6 pm to award the bid.

Bridge grant application must be submitted by March 24th to apply for \$225 million federal funds available for use of Wisconsin town bridges. The town of Belgium has 3 bridges that are speculated to qualify for the bridge grant. (Cedar Beach, Dixie, 6 mile)

Spring Road Inspection is scheduled for April 15th at 7 am.

**T/F site**: Compliments to Oz Co for clean up after storm. No reported equipment problems this winter. Inquiry to residents about new hours: 1 comment that some people are having a hard time getting there who work on Saturday mornings.

August 2023 contract is up to expire

Tom Bichler will get 3 quotes for upcoming year- will discuss at April 3 mtg if quotes can be arranged in time.

**New Business**: Emergency Medical Services Agreement motioned to approve by Tom Winker, second by Tom Bichler, Motion carried unanimously.

**Citizen Input**: Dan Large NSOD brought up the concern of operating funds/upcoming referendum and student growth. A meeting is being held at the fine arts building 3/13 at 7pm to discuss how to improve small family growth to encourage student growth to secure more operating funds.
